>From D1 secretary, Francois Denner, I received the result of letter ballot for new reporter "Effect of ambient light on Color Appearance of softcopy images", the deadline of which was July 31.

The result is:
A total of 13 replies were received from the 39 country members.
Twelve of them were in favor, and one against.

The disagreement was from USNC and is summarized as follows;
1) need to clarify on the type of adaptation to be investigated,
2) no consideration for luminance level difference,
3) no description on room light intensity to be investigated,
4) misquoting on the CIE guidelines for coordinate research of CIE TC1-34 and TC1-27 which appeared in CRA,
5) no reference cited for relevant studies in Taiwan.

These comments are being sent to Mr. Katoh with asking for further consideration to make the proposal more clear and understandable.

After receiving his reply, we will evaluate the ballot finally.
